Gate Transmitters: Gate clickers can be purchased for \$40 at the District Office from the General Manager, Angela Johnson 677-5889. Please call for appointment.

Gate Transmitter Battery Replacement: Gate clicker battery replacement: Duracell security 21/23(12v NM21/A23) or another brand equivalent.

Burn Piles: A permit is required for some residential burn piles. Burning is only allowed on "permissive burn days". Permits can be obtained at Station 89 in Cameron Park. Please call 621-5897 before you burn. **All burn barrels have been banned and it is illegal to burn household garbage.**

No Sprav Signs can be removed as the weed spraying is finished for this year. Those signs should just be installed on your property temporarily and removed when the spraying is completed.

Notices from the Board

1. **Keep your overhanging trees and brush from growing into the District roadways.** It is hazardous for drivers and walkers. The District will be enforcing the Easement Policy so please it carefully.
2. Now that fire season is in full swing, please make sure you have cleared 100 foot around your dwellings. Also **keep the brush down on your property and the road easements.** Thank you.
3. **Do not attach signs of any kind to the gate pillars or green monuments--**they will be removed. The glue from tape gets on the rock of the pillars and it ruins the finish of the monuments. Please use wooden stakes or frames for your signs.
5. **Please wait for the gate to completely open before you proceed through the gates.** Let your visitors know too.
