Meetings are at LOTH Church, 3100 Rodeo Road, Cameron Park, 7:00 p.m., the 3rd Thursday of every other month. The Agenda and meeting documents are posted at the green monuments by the entrance gates and on the CECSD website 72 hours prior to the meeting. **The Board invites and welcomes you to attend.**

Highlights of the January Meeting

- 1. The Board appointed Doris Miller as President and Eva Robertson as Vice-President.
- 2. The Board approved contracting with a new legal counsel, David McMurchie of McMurchie Law
- 3. The Board approved revision of the wording on the Advisory Vote Ballot Measure for the June 7th Election to read " Should the General Plan be amended to change the zoning of approximately 3100 acres adjacent to Cameron Estates, known as Marble Valley and Lime Rock Valley, to increase the maximum number of allowable dwelling units from 400 to approximately 4,035 dwelling units?" .
- 4. After considering General Manager Staff Report and the Legal Opinion Memo from attorney Bill Wright the Board did not take any action to pursue installation of traffic calming devices in the District.
- 5. A District resident requested that the Board place an item on a future Agenda for a discussion between the Board and the residents regarding the possibility of removing the gate code posting at the entrances.

In addition, any time the animal is removed from an enclosed private lot or enclosed private space they need to be confined on a leash of not more than ten feet in length.
