### Clear your Yards: Dangerous Fire Season!

As we are all well aware of the wildfires throughout California, **please** cut your weeds, and trim your trees and brush back from the roads and road easements. Make sure you look at the whole tree or bush and cut them back to clear the road easement 10 feet from the edge of the road asphalt and 13 feet 6 inches above it. Insurance companies are starting to cancel policies for homeowners living in dangerous fire areas, as well as canceling policies for homeowners that live next to a property that is not fire safe!! ### Notices From the Board of Directors

1. The Board voted to place Ballot **Measure H**, in the November 6<sup>th</sup> General Election, asking the voters to increase the Special Tax by \$345 over and above the current special tax rate of \$250 per parcel per year. If approved the special tax would increase to \$595 per year and would bring in an additional \$100,740 for road improvements and maintenance. The current special tax has not increased in over 30 years and is not enough to keep up with the increasing costs of road repair and maintenance. In order to create and maintain safe drivable roads our District needs more revenues and needs your support to achieve this. Please see the attached Fact Sheet to get more information and understanding as to why the Board has placed Measure H on the November ballot.
