Notices From the Board of Directors

According to www.preventwildfireca.org here are some tips to cut weeds, brush and trees safely:

Mowing: Mow before 10 a.m., but never when it is windy or excessively dry. Lawn mowers are designed to mow lawns, not weeds or dry grass. **Metal blades striking rocks can create sparks and start fire.** Use caution!

Equipment Use: In wildland areas, grinding and welding operations require a permit and 10 feet of clearance. Keep a shovel and a fire extinguisher ready to use. Don't drive your vehicle onto dry grass or brush. Hot exhaust pipes and mufflers can start fires. Keep a cell phone nearby and call 911 immediately in case of fire.

Spark Arresters: In wildland areas, spark arresters are required on all portable gasoline-powered equipment. This includes tractors, harvesters, chainsaws, weed-eaters and mowers. Keep exhaust systems, spark arresters and mowers in proper working order and free of carbon buildup. Use the recommended grade of fuel and don't top it off."
