El Dorado County Development Projects

There are three very large projects in the El Dorado County Planning Department. Marble Valley, Lime Rock Valley, and Town and Country Village. All three plan to use the Bass Lake exit off Highway 50 as the main entrance. Marble Valley and Lime Rock Valley will also use Cambridge near the Flying C gates as another entrance or exit to the development.
